INVITATION TO BID**

The Immokalee Fire Control District (“Owner”) is requesting sealed Bids for the construction of the District’s new Fire Station #30 in Immokalee (“Project”) located at 510 New Market Road east. Bids shall be submitted to the attention of Deputy Chief Greenberg, at the address listed below no later than 2:00pm EST on March 17, 2021: Immokalee Fire Control District, 502 New Market Road E., Immokalee, FL. 34142, (239) 657-2111

Funding for this project is provided by the Collier County Division of Community and Human Resources and the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) using Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. Federal Regulations during construction will be enforced, including Davis Bacon and Related Acts for wage rates.

Bids will be publicly read on March 18, 2021 (at the address above) and a tentative contractor will be identified at the Immokalee Fire Control District Board meeting. Verification of experience will be completed within 10 days, cost analysis of the bids will be completed by Collier County Division of Community and Human Services and execution of a final contract and terms will be finalized not later than May 20, 2021. There is no intended or implied agreement until the final contract and terms are executed by the Immokalee Board of Fire Commissioners.

Minority, female-owned and small businesses are encouraged to submit bids for this project.
